

ATTACK ON LORD LANDSDOWNE KEEP THEM AT HOME. A Montreal Newspaper Holds Him up to the Scorn of the Public.

OTTAWA, Ont., March 26 .- Lord Lands downe is seldom seen in the streets of the capital nowadays. Since the reports of his treatment of Irish tenants reached Canada he has been much abused. The Montreal Post has made him the object of a bitter attack, charging him with having concentrated within himself all the worst qualities of an ancestry that it would be gross flattery to dignify with the bar-sinister. He is accused with living n luxurious idleness at the cost of \$100,000 a year paid by the mass of toiling ools who go by the name of Canadian peoole, while a system of wholesale evictions is carried on against his tenants on his Queens county estates. He has lied openly, the Post says, to avert the opprobrium which he knows his conduct must entail.

"In his person," it says, "we have a good specimen of the absentee landlord. Rolling in wealth and luxury, he would squeeze the last drop of blood out of the people whom confiscation, murder, and devisish infamy have placed under his hartless control as tenants on the land of their natural heritage.'

Much indignation has been aroused by n the hands of the minister of justice. Regarding the attacks which have been made upon him, Lard Landsdowne said to

DIMENSIONS OF THE THISTLE The Scotch Yacht Will be the Largest Rac-

ing Cutter Yet Built. Boston, March 28 .- The Scotch cutter

Thistle, now building in Scotland from plans by Mr. George L. Watson, will be about 90 feet on the water line. She will be 4 9-10 feet longer than the Galatea, and

53-10 feet wider on the beam. The Genesta is 9 feet shorter and 5 feet narrower Longer than the Galatea, and with more beam 'and with considerable more sail area, she will, no doubt, have great driving power, and this is just what Mr. Watson has always advocated-that the hull must be made to correspond with the driving power which is to be put upon it. From these measurements it appear that the Thistle is a cutter built especially for moderate weather. If the measurements given are the actual ones, the Thistle is the ongest racing cutter yet built and will prove a formidable antagonist to the American sloops, now that the ongest of them, the Mayflower, is going abroad. The correspondent of Glasgow who furnishes these figures also says that the cutter is of steel, with smooth plating above the water line, and "in and out" plating below. The official measurements,




