A Regular Water Famine in Altoona.

Dirty linen and darkness are the latest probabilities of the Altoona water famine. Two of the largest laundries in the city were burned out Monday night, and the others cannot get enough water, dirty as it is, to do their work.

The East Side electric light plant must close down unless more water is furnished, and the other plant is kept in operation through the generosity of the Pennsylvania railroad company, which has permitted the running of a hose line from one of its plugs to the big boilers.

Go Into Operation.

It is announced that a new postal money order system will go into operation some time this month. The amounts issued will be from \$1 to \$13. On payment of one cent and the amount to be sent, the order will be torn off about the same as an express order. There will be no writing on it by the postmaster the sender indorsing it as a check or draft. The government guarantees its safe transportation.—Ex.
