The New York World in a telegram received at Bellefonte late last night, says the World's returns indicate that Cleveland will have 281 votes in the electoral college.

It was a landslide on Tuesday. Cleveland and Stevenson were elected by big majorities. Large Democratic gains were made throughout the country and such a sweeping victory surprised even the Democrats.

Wisconsin Conceded to Democrats. Milwaukee, Wis., Nov. 9.—The Democrats have carried Wisconsin.

Both senate and house are Democratic and the party are in complete control of the national government.

The returns from Pennsylvania were slow in coming in and it was about the last state to be heard from.

In the county the vote was near out, and the majorities are near a thousand. All the Democratic candidates in the county were elected.

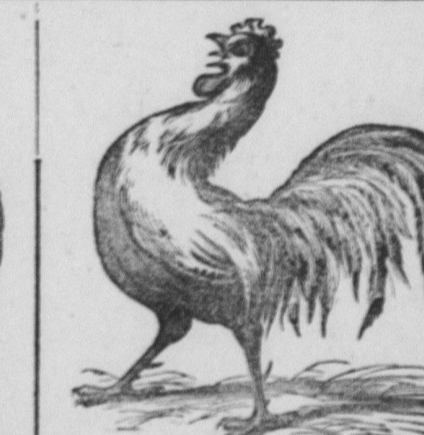
