RETREAT WINS FOR SUFFRAGE

With Lieutenant Governor's Aid Women Avoid Defeat of Rights

CHANGE OF VOTE DENIED

Beldeman Angrily Objects When Huffman Tries to Aid the Fair Sex—First Time in Thirteen Years Tie Vote Is Broken.

(Special Harrisburg Correspondence.) Harrisburg.—For the first time in 13 years the Lieutenant-Governor, as president of the Senate, was called upon to exercise his constitutional privilege of voting in case of a tie vote in that body, and in doing so Lieutenant-Governor Reynolds not only saved the Woman Suffrage measure from defeat, but practically gave the advocates of that measure a temporary victory that may yet bear the fruit in a permanent triumph.

Powell Asks Postponement. To this end Senator Powell, sponsor for the Rockwell measure, having introduced a similar one in the Senate, moved to postpone for the present.

Herbst Eager for Action. Senator Herbst, Berks, impatiently demanded a vote on the bill now. What was the use of postponing the inevitable? asked Herbst, meaning the bill's defeat.

Previous Agreement Cited. "There was an understanding," said Powell, "when this bill was reported out that unless all Senators were present the bill should be postponed," and he wanted that agreement carried out.

Eagerly Keeping Tally. Lieutenant-Governor Reynolds was about to order a call of the roll on Powell's motion to postpone, when Senator Melhenny, of Philadelphia, arose to remark that whatever vote he cast on Powell's motion was not to be construed on the merits of the resolution.

State Funds Received. Receipts at the State Treasury were \$2,441,085.66 during the month of March, and the disbursements \$2,574,373.13, the excess of disbursements over receipts being \$133,337.57.

OLLIE ON THE FARM

Good Dog Is as Essential as Other Live Stock.

Tough-Coated Scotch Variety Is Not Only Useful—Around Sheep, but Can Be Taught to Drive Cattle and Keep Watch.

There is nothing more companionable when rambling through the woods or walking in the country than a fine dog. On the farm a dog—a good one—is as essential as other live stock.

The rough-coated Scotch collie is one of the oldest breeds of dogs. Its history extends way back into ancient times when dogs of this breed were used by the shepherds to care for their flocks.

One collie was brought to this country from England several years ago for \$5,000, and one came last year at the reported price of \$6,500.

MAKING THE PLOWING EASIER

Hardest Work That the Farm Horse Are Called Upon to Perform—Keep Shares Sharpened.

Plowing is at best the hardest work our farm horses have to perform. Few plow teams are not doing 10 to 30 per cent. of unnecessary work.

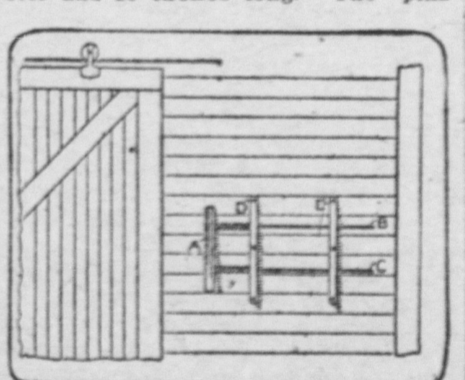
We are told that about 50 per cent. of the draft of a plow is due to the cutting of the furrow slice. The condition of the cutting edge must then be of first importance.

The set and adjustment of a plow has almost as much to do with the draft as condition of the share.

To accomplish this the rear furrow wheel is set out about an inch and a quarter so that landside cannot touch the side furrow.
