SERVING CART WORTH WHILE

Saves Much Work for the Housewife Who Has No Retinue of Hired Help.

If the woman who does her own housework is to dine comfortably and enjoy that important meal from start to finish with her family, she positively must have a serving cart. This horseless vehicle is an enlarged edition of the teacart, and has four shelves instead of the single one below the tea-equipage tray. During the meal this contrivance stands at the right hand of the housewife and from its upper shelf she passes the with the fish or meat course plates, which meanwhile have been keeping warm between sheets of white flannel on the second shelf.

The salad and fruit courses are easily served in turn from two lower shelves, and meanwhile the coffee has been making itselfs in a percolator standing at one end of the topmost shelf. It is to have a dinner cart en route with the dining room furniture. but very good looking "dumb waitresses" are of inexpensive wood, white enamel painted.




