January 21, 1885.

Track on our railroad is now near to the borders of Lemont.

J. B. Solt is running a lime kiln at the station with stones taken from the mill cellar.

The Centre Hall band has revived, and practices in its hall under the head of James Lohr.

Dr. Charles Emerick has again returned to Philadelphia to finish his course in the medical college.

The contract for digging ditch, taking up old and painting and laying new pipe and covering same, on upper end of Centre Hall water route, was awarded D. F. Luse, lowest bidder, at \$1 per rod. The lower end, for digging, laying and covering was awarded D. K. Gdiss, lowest bid, at 80c per rod.

Curry-Glasgow.

John Jeffrey Curry, the well known labor leader and Salvation Army worker, was gloriously married on Sept. 4, the happy bride being Miss Anna Glasgow, of Linden Hall, Centre county. While the wedding was unusual and a little peculiar in a general way, yet it was one of the most solemn and consecrating services of its kind ever held in Tyrone.

The auditorium of the Y. M. C. A. was used for the event and the building was not a bit too large as at least six or seven hundred people attended and took part in the ceremony that preceded and followed the taking of the sacred vows.

It was an out and out Salvation Army wedding and being the first ever held here, naturally our people were interested and gladly accepted the invitation that was so kindly extended by Mr. Curry and his bride.

The active members of the Army assembled on the stage of the auditorium and held a devotional service during which old gospel hymns such as "Joyful, Joyful Will the Meeting Be," "Are You Washed in the Blood of the Lamb?" and "In the Sweet Bye and Bye" were heartily sung by the Salvationists and those in the audience, ably led by Mrs. David Fullmer, a soldier of the Army, of Chester, Pa. Following the bridal party came on the stage and then Captain Snyder took charge.

After singing "Draw Me Nearer," Mrs. Snyder, wife of Captain Snyder, made an earnest prayer. Mrs. Fullmer who has a remarkably sweet voice sang "There Never Was One Like Jesus." The wedding ceremony was then performed by Rev. A. S. Fasick D. D., pastor of the First Methodist Episcopal church, who preceded the vows taken by a few timely and interesting remarks.

The bride and groom left Tyrone on a trip to the eastern cities.
