February 4, 1885.
The German folks of the upper end of the Loop had a little party at John Slack's, the other evening, and had a gay time.

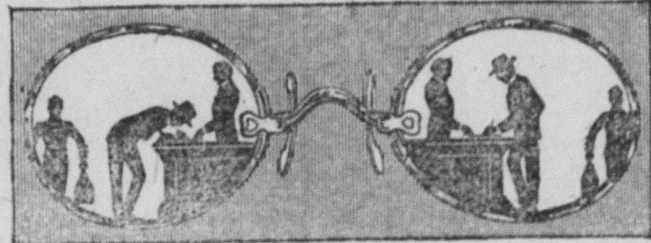
