**BOND THEFTS LAID TO MASTER ROBBER**

Trusted Messenger Boys in New York Lured to Life of Crime.

New York.—The sinister hand of a master robber has been directing the series of bond thefts, which has resulted in the loss, through trusted employees of banking and brokerage houses in the financial district of New York city, of nearly \$1,000,000, according to the belief of the police.

In no other manner can the authorities account for the fact that inexperienced boys, some of them just out of school, have been able to plan and execute successfully thefts of securities on a gigantic scale. No boy's brain, it

is contended, could plan some of the robberies which have started Wall street.

Many of the best trained minds of New York city's detective force, besides scores of private detectives in the employ of financial institutions and bonding companies which have lost heavily, are seeking the criminal whose master mind directs the work of the actual operatives. They are working on the theory that the arch-criminal is a man of unusual ability with an intimate knowledge of the habits of financial houses, and the apparently loose methods in which they send securities about the Wall street district in the pockets or satchels carried by young clerks.

It is believed agents of the master criminal escape acquaintance with banking and brokerage house messengers, manage to involve them in small debts, lure them to increase the debts in the hope of "getting even" and then, when they are hopelessly entangled, open before them the glittering and easy rewards of a life of crime.

**Man Fell Eight Stories, Landed in Rocking Chair**

James Hamilton, 35 years old, a telegraph operator, of Kingston Springs, Tenn., fell or was pushed—he doesn't recall which—from an eight-story window of a St. Louis hotel.

He landed in a sitting posture in a rocking chair on the sidewalk, escaping with slight injuries due to his fall being broken by two electric wire cables at the height of the second story. He is being treated at the hospital for a cut head and splinter wound in the right side.

**UNDER WATER 18 MINUTES**

Man Is Rescued and Resuscitated by Crew of Patrol Boat—May Recover.

Philadelphia.—After being under water in the Delaware for eighteen minutes Frank Burke was rescued and resuscitated by the crew of the patrol boat.

Burke, an employe of the Cramp shipyards, fell into the water from a hull on which he was working and disappeared beneath the surface, after struggling for a few minutes.

Fellow workmen made several attempts to rescue him, but were unsuccessful until the arrival of the patrol boat. Burke was located with grappling hooks and rushed to the emergency hospital at the shipyard. Here the pulmotor was applied. Physicians say Burke may recover.

**Must Build Jail for Youth.**  
Walla Walla, Wash.—Penitentiary authorities here must build a separate prison cell and yard for the confinement of one prisoner, Frank Sowers, sixteen years old. By a decision of the state supreme court the youth must be imprisoned for manslaughter, but a state law bars offenders of tender age from adult criminals' association. Under conviction for manslaughter a prisoner cannot be sent to the state reform school.
