July 15 1885.

State Agricultural Notes.

March is generally regarded as the critical month for the grain, due to the alternate freezing and thawing. There has been little danger from that source this year, however.

The Bureau of Animal Industry of the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture urges all hog owners employing the double treatment to keep close touch with the veterinarians and arrange for the vaccination of their spring pigs at the proper time. To delay the treatment may cause the loss of all of these pigs.

In Lancaster county, 57 per cent of the farmers are feeding steers for the spring market. This county leads the state, Adams county ranking second with 29 per cent. In the entire state 9 per cent of the farmers are feeding cattle for market.

The condition of wheat in Pennsylvania is estimated at 93 per cent, as compared with a normal or full crop condition. Damage in a number of sections of the state were caused by the ice which formed on the wheat fields early in the winter.

Westmoreland county ranks first in Pennsylvania in the number of pure bred stallions, Susquehanna in the number of pure bred bulls and Washington and Greene counties tie for the first place in rams.

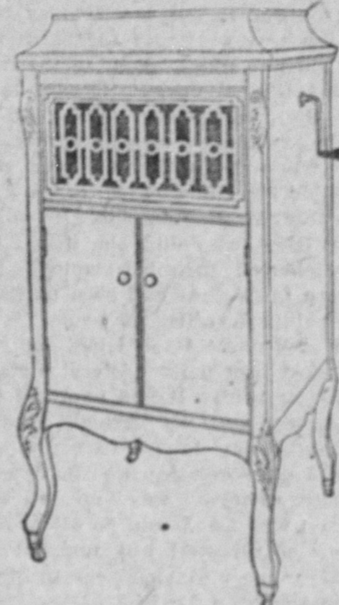

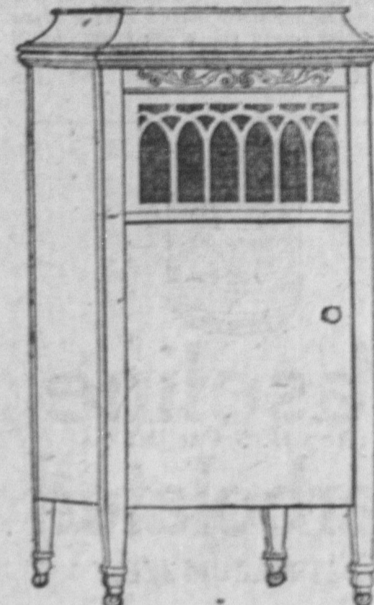

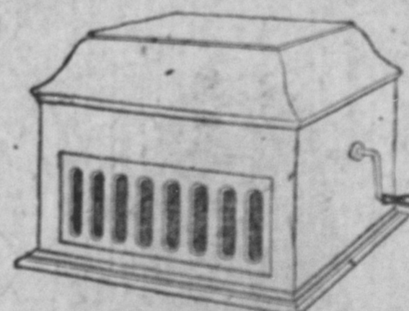
