Roll out 4-inch thick on floured board; brush with melted boutter, sprinkle with sugar, cinnamon and raisins. Roll as for jelly roll; cut into 14-inch pieces, place with cut edges up on well-greased pan; sprinkle with a little sugar and cinnamon. Bake in moderate oven 30 to 35 minutes; remove from pan once.




