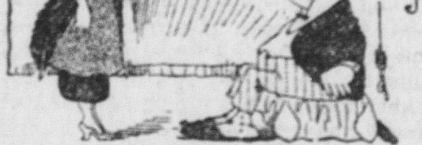
"Where's Clarence?" some one asked of a former business associate of the young man.

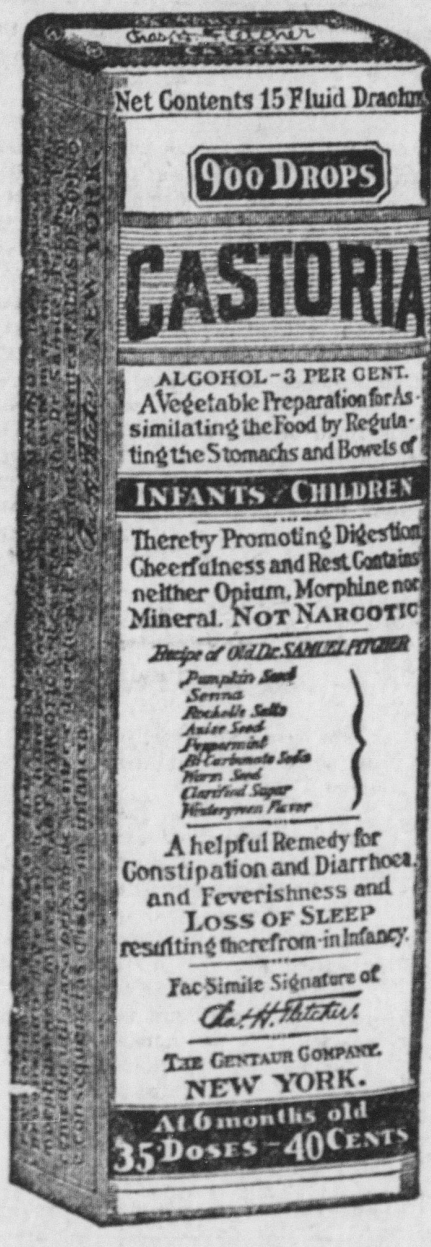
