URGING TO BUY GOVERNMENT SECURITIES.

Chairman Walker Is Making Appeal to Investors to Buy the Best Securities to be Had.

Chairman W. Harrison Walker is making an appeal to investors to buy the best securities offered today, which is the War Savings Stamp in one or the other of its forms.

It may interest you to know that from January 1st to August 1st, 1921, there have been twenty-eight \$1,000 Certificates sold in our county, and the holders of these securities are the patrons of the following post offices: Centre Hall 8, Phillipsburg 5, Bellefonte 5, Zion 3, Fleming 3, Bodeburg 2, Rebersburg 1, Spring Mills 1. "I am glad to say," says Mr. Walker, "that since the issue of the Savings Securities in 1918, Centre county has been among the leading counties of Pennsylvania. Our per capita record is as follows: in 1918, \$20.28, ranking fourth; in 1919 it had second place with a per capita of \$2.60; in 1920 it won first place with a per capita of 97 cents. During the month of October we added four \$1,000 Certificates, which makes our per capita a little over 1.00.

Leaves State-Centre.

A. J. Musser, of Indiana, resigned as secretary and treasurer of the State Centre Electric company, and accepted the position as general manager of the Clearfield Bituminous Coal Corporation and other interests of the New York Central Railroad in Pennsylvania. In this capacity he will have general supervision of the farms, mines, stores, lumber interests, etc., of the company, which is a gigantic undertaking and requires a man of Mr. Musser's ability who enters upon his duties with the best wishes of his many Centre county friends where he was born being a son of John Musser, deceased, late of Pine Grove Mills.

P. T. Davis, treasurer of the Clearfield Trust Co., was elected to fill the vacancy caused by Mr. Musser's resignation.

Tuberculosis Day.

Governor Sproul opened the fourteenth annual Christmas Seal Sale in Pennsylvania Monday by the purchase of the first Seals.

In connection with the 1921 Christmas Seal Sale in Pennsylvania, tuberculosis day will be observed in the schools on Friday, December 9th, and tuberculosis day in the churches on Sunday, December 11th. These days will be features of Health Week, December 5th to 11th inclusive, which will be observed by local branches of the Pennsylvania Tuberculosis Society and other local health and civic organizations in co-operation with Rotary Clubs.

The vacant associate judgeship of Union county was filled on Friday by appointment of Ammon E. Reedy by Governor Sproul. Mr. Reedy lives near Lewisburg and is a Republican. He will be commissioned immediately.


