Improved Disinfectant Soap.

Austria reports a new development in the manufacture of disinfectant soaps, which it is claimed has proved a decided success. The disinfectant used is lactate of silver and a very small amount produces remarkable results. The soap has been used in hospitals for general washing purposes, for sterilizing instruments (it does not contain any corrosive ingredients and hence can be safely used for this purpose), disinfecting clothes, rubber gloves, etc.
