The constituency of the Lutheran church, nominal members, children. etc., was recently given by Dr. E. O. Watson, Statistician of the Federal Council of churches in America, as being 7.043,854 members; 11,700 pastors minister to congregations.

The American Lutheran Chuchi is conducting nearly 200 schools of higher education, seminaries, colleges and academies, with 1.500 teachers and 13,-000 students. During the last sixty years the Lutheran Church in this country has doubled its membership every fourteen years.
