QUALIFICATIONS OF SAFE DRIVER

He Should Know That His Car Is in Good Condition Before Starting.

What are the qualifications of a safe automobile driver? The National Safety Council answers the question herewith: In order to be a safe driver, the individual must be of good moral character, possessed of all his senses, understand his responsibility, have consideration for the rights of others and be able to act promptly. He should know that the car is in such condition that no accident will result from defective equipment. He should refuse to operate a car which has defective brakes for his own and others' safety; he should know by actual application of the brakes that they function properly so that, should the occasion arise to use them, he can depend upon them to stop his car.

Examine Before Starting.
He should examine the car before starting to see that it is in good operating condition, that is, such items as the steering, gas and oil supply. He should know that the headlights are properly focused, tires properly inflated and the spare tire ready for service.

He should be sure to use skid chains when it starts to rain or snow or when desirable for safety under other conditions, and should never speed or drive in a reckless manner. He should be careful today—tomorrow may be too late to avoid an accident, for accidents do not happen; they are caused and a well-qualified driver is never in too big a hurry to be careful, for he who takes chances usually takes one too many.

Caution at Corners.
At blind corners where buildings or trees obstruct the view, he should reduce his speed, sound the horn and keep the car under perfect control. He should drive slowly and carefully when approaching children at play. He should never count on them to see him or to be able to take care of themselves for he is responsible for their safety.

He should co-operate with the traffic officers to the fullest extent, for it is their intention to help. All traffic rules of the state, cities and boroughs, through which the car is operated, should be observed. Accidents do not happen—they are caused.

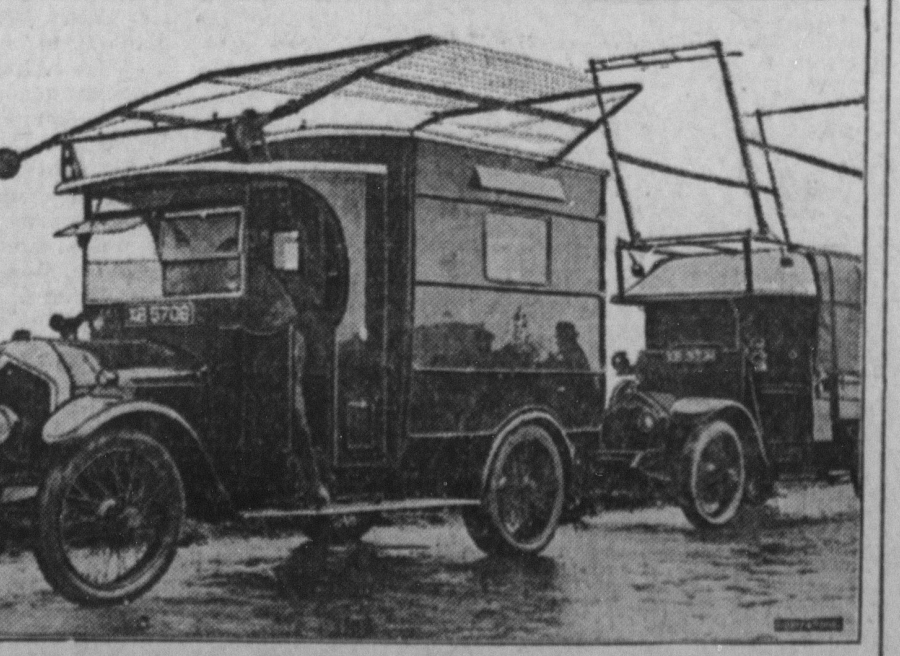
Some Good Suggestions on Cleaning Cylinders

When the cylinder head of a motor is detached for the purpose of removing the carbon deposit, it will be noticed that during the process of scraping the piston, etc., the tapped holes on the top of the cylinder casting soon get full of oily carbon, water, etc., causing trouble to remove when it is decided to insert the holding down set screws, writes R. O. Allen in the American Motorist. To obviate this I have used short screws without heads on, but with a screwdriver slot cut in them, and screw them in flush with the top of the cylinder casting before scraping operations are commenced. After the decarbonizing is completed the grub screws can be removed, when holes will be found to be free from dirt.

Dent in Gasoline Line Will Check Fuel Flow

A dent of some depth in the gasoline line may be sufficient to so restrict the flow as to cause erratic car-jerk action, misfiring, etc. Likewise a very abrupt upward bend is likely to cause the formation of an air pocket and restrict the flow. Both of these conditions are likely to give greatest trouble at the higher speeds when the fuel demand is highest. A trap in the fuel line, if allowed to accumulate water or dirt, may in time become so full of foreign substances as to prevent the free flow of gasoline. Periodic cleaning of the whole gas line and the straightening of dented portions will prove valuable in getting good engine operation.

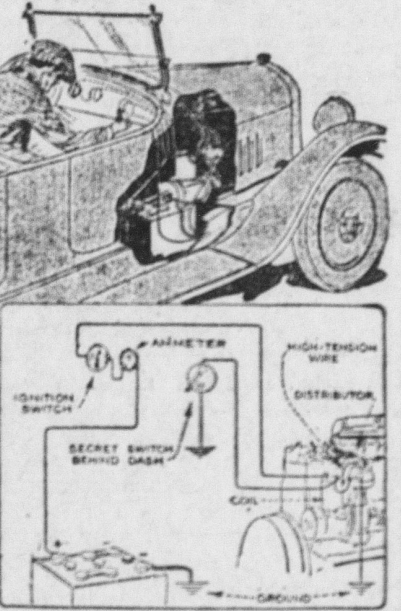
RADIO IS USED TO TRACE MOTOR BANDITS



The photograph shows motor cars from Scotland Yard police headquarters equipped with radio to either send or receive messages. The cars were employed in the recent police chase of the motor bandits who held up and robbed the Everholt Street post office, getting away with 16 bags of mail containing money orders, etc. The various sections of the police "flying squad" are thus able to keep in communication with each other.

About Driving Cars
It takes four qualities to be a good driver of an automobile—even the cheapest. You must be able to—
Drive safely.
Drive fast—not all the time, but when it is necessary—fast but still safely.
Be easy on your passengers—partly a matter of springs, but much more a matter of skill.
Be easy on your engine and car; any fool can abuse a good machine.
We know, and no doubt you know, many drivers who have two of these qualities, and some who have three. The ones who have all four are rare, indeed. Repair shops, hospitals, and police courts seldom see them.

Secret Switch Prevents Theft of Automobiles
With his snap-on jumper wire an auto thief can readily bridge the ignition wires of a car, when the switch is thrown off, and complete the circuit, which enables him to get away with the car. To prevent this many auto-ists have a secret ignition switch in addition to the regular one, but the auto thief, after first bridging the regular switch, notices that there is no discharge on the ammeter, which indicates an open circuit, and so he finds the second switch and bridges this one, too. However, the switch and connection shown in the drawing will foil the

expert thief, as with this arrangement the correct discharge is shown on the ammeter after the regular switch has been bridged, but the coil is grounded so that the car cannot be operated. This is accomplished by mounting an extra switch behind the dash, of which one side is connected to the frame of the car and the other to the spark coil by carefully concealed wires. Ordinarily, when the car is running, this switch is open, but it is closed to make the ignition system theft-proof.—Richard P. Cole, Paterson, N. J., in Popular Mechanics Magazine.

Tight Chains Are Always Injurious to the Tire

Like many other useful things, tire chains are entirely proper when used at the right time and in the right manner. When badly adjusted they furnish a route to ruined tires.

Motorists often discover cuts at regular intervals around a tire. When this condition is found it is a pretty safe bet that tight chains were used. It is never wise to fasten chains on tightly. The more loosely a chain is applied the less damage to the tire will result. This is because a loose chain distributes the strain all over the tire, instead of at certain points. The wise motorists will also avoid the use of chains on paved streets except in cases of snow or ice. A tire damaged by chains should go to the repair shop. Too much expert treatment is required to bring its usefulness back for the motorist to attempt the repairs himself. When the streets are in such condition that chains are necessary for safe driving, by all means use them and see that they are properly applied.
