Cullen Gets \$36,400 Verdict.

A verdict in the sum of \$36,400 was rendered in favor of James Cullen, who brought suit against the estate of Charles Rowland, for royalties on coal in a real estate transaction of some years ago.

A year ago a verdict was given in the same case for \$45,000, but a new trial was asked by the Rowland estate, and this was granted. The verdict, Saturday, was in full amount of the original claim, with interest at four per cent. The verdict last year gave interest at six per cent.

U. E. Refuse to Merge.

The East Pennsylvania conference of the United Evangelical church re-

jected the overture of the Evangelical church to merge, at a session held in Lancaster on Monday. A committee headed by Bishop W. C. Hell, submitted its report to the conference and it was adopted.
