STOP PULLET MOLT.—Many early hatched pullets, which came into laying early, will go into a molt for from 4 to 8 weeks. If the birds are housed before they start laying, fed heavily with scratch grain, and artificial lights used moderately, this molting can be cut down to a minimum, and the egg production hold to 50 to 60 per cent.
