

This service includes clinics, which rive health examinations, and medi-

fore medical societies, nurses and other groups. In the clinics emphasis is laid on chest examinations. The One of the important pieces of work | clinics are conducted by the medical director of the Pennsylvania Tuberculosis Society in co-operation with physicians in the communities where they are held.

In the first ten months of 1927 these clinics showed the following records: 88 clinics held. 2.746 persons examined.


TUBERCULOSIS DAY
