Timely Reminders from The Pennsylvania State College.

CLEAN UP CORN BORER—Before heavy snows come, farmers and gardeners living in the corn borer infested area of the State, will find it valuable to clean up all trash and remnants in the corn fields and sweet corn patches. If dry enough, these can be burned. Where the amount is small, burying will dispose of it effectively.

RUNNING WATER A BENEFIT—With the weather growing colder the housewife who has running water in her kitchen can be thankful she does not have to go to the pump every time a pull of water is needed. Your county agent has information on how to install plumbing and there also is a septic tank form in your county for the use of farmers building their own sewage disposal plant. From him you also can get the State College circular on septic tanks.

GOOD FEED BRINGS PROFITS—Full-fed cows give brimming pails of milk. Feed liberally, yet carefully, of balanced rations, says State College dairy specialists. It pays well to buy high protein feeds, such as cottonseed meal or linseed oil meal to mix with home-grown corn oats, barley and buckwheat. Do not miss this means of getting extra profit.

CLOSED DOOR INSURES HEALTH—A low chick mortality of 9.3 per cent was reported by Pennsylvania poultrymen who raised their chicks in complete confinement this year. These reports were obtained for a total of 12,309 chicks brooded under the "closed door" plan outlined by the poultry extension department of the Pennsylvania State College. A low chick mortality and freedom from intestinal parasites are two advantages of the plan.

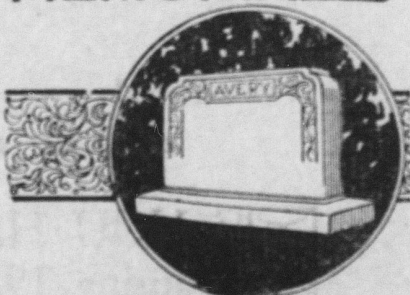

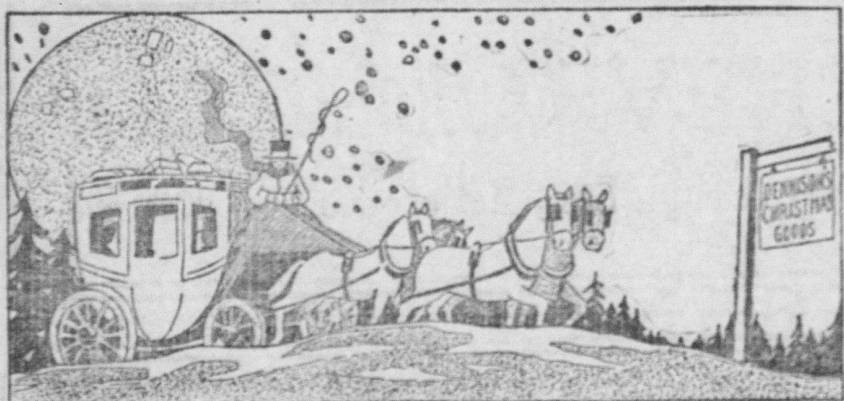
