Taking evergreen trees and shrubs from land that does not belong to the one who helps himself is an offense carrying with it a penalty of \$25 and costs of prosecution for each tree or shrub removed. It costs less to buy the Christmas decorations.

Good Cows Pay Best—

Dairy cows differ in their ability to pay the farmer good prices for his grain and hay crops. Low-producing cows should be culled out to increase the value of the herd as a market for feeds consumed, say State College dairy specialists.

To Award Honey Prizes—

Honey producers will share a prize fund of \$232.50 at the coming State Farm Products Show in Harrisburg. Awards will be made for comb and extracted honey, culinary products in which honey is substituted for sugar, and honey candies.

Paper Used on Garden—

Mulch paper is a said to be worthwhile for certain early crops of high market value and in some home gardens where it is desired to eliminate cultivation and to utilize space to the best advantage.

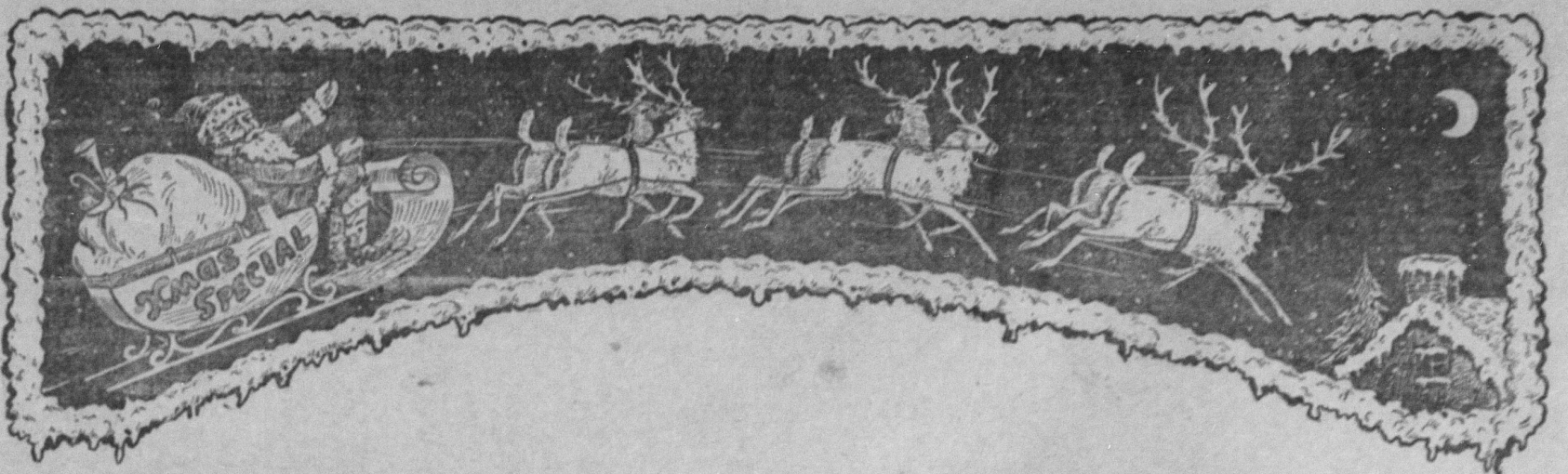
