Feed Needy Helfers-

Prune Pine Trees-

It will pay to prune the lower branch- (Political Advertisement.) es of white and red pine trees when they are not over four inches in diameter. Choose a good straight pine every 15 to 20 feet in the plantation and cut the limbs at one operation. Continue pruning the tree to a distance of 17 feet above the ground, which will provide a 16-foot log free from limbs and knots.

Select Seed In FleId-

Seed corn selected rom the standing stalks will yield better than that picked from the wagon box or crib. Field selection permits the picker to observe the position of the ear on the stalk. the size of the plant, and other conditions of growth.

Treat Seed Wheat-

To control stinking smut of wheat clean seed should be planted. If any Democratic Candidate for Commissiontraces of smut are found the seed should be treated with two and one half ounces of copper carbonate dust per bushel after the seed has been carefully cleaned.


