Entomologists of State College calm these fears by saying that the lady bird beetles feed on plant lice and other soft-bodied insects, which makes them beneficial and not injurious. FERTILIZE THE GARDEN—Where a liberal application of manure has been made to the garden, only 16 or 20 per cent superphosphate will be needed. With a moderate application of barnyard manure, a 4-12-4 fertilizer will give the best results. On gardens receiving little or no manure a 4-8-4
