Add one cup of cooked diced carrots, fresh or the contents of one 8-ounce can, one can of New England oven baked beans and one 12-ounce can of corned beef. Season to taste, and heat thoroughly. Serves eight.*

Chocolate Works Wonders With Simple Desserts



As a help in planning daily desserts, chocolate has long been a boon to housewives. To such simple desserts as steamed or cottage pudding, tapioca or custard, chocolate brings a new appeal. And, for good measure, chocolate also adds considerable food value to these desserts—an important consideration when winter winds blow.

Steamed Chocolate Pudding
2 cups sifted cake flour
2 teaspoons double-action baking powder
1/4 teaspoon soda
1/4 teaspoon salt
1/2 cup butter or other shortening
1/2 cup sugar
1 egg, well beaten
3 squares unsweetened chocolate, melted
1 1/2 cups milk
Sift flour once, measure, add baking powder, soda, and salt, and sift together three times. Cream butter, add sugar gradually, and cream together thoroughly. Add egg and chocolate, heating until smooth. Add flour, alternately with milk, a small amount at a time. Beat well after each addition. Turn into greased mold, cover, and steam 2 hours. Serve hot with hard sauce. Garnish with whipped cream, if desired. Serves 10.

Baked Chocolate Custard
3 squares unsweetened chocolate
4 cups milk

4 eggs, slightly beaten
1/2 cup sugar
1/4 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon vanilla
Add chocolate to milk and heat in double boiler. When chocolate is melted, beat with rotary egg beater until blended. Combine eggs, sugar, and salt; add chocolate mixture gradually, stirring until sugar is dissolved. Add vanilla and pour into custard cups. Place in pan of hot water and bake in slow oven (325° F.) 1 hour, or until knife inserted comes out clean. (Water in pan should not reach boiling temperature.) Chill. Unmold and serve with cream, if desired. Serves 8.

Chocolate Rice Pudding
1 square unsweetened chocolate, cut in pieces
3 cups milk
3 cups rice
1/2 cup sugar
1/4 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon vanilla
Add chocolate to milk in double boiler and heat. When chocolate is melted, beat with rotary egg beater until blended. Add rice gradually, then add sugar and salt, and cook 1 1/2 to 2 hours longer, or until rice is soft, stirring occasionally. Cool; add vanilla. Chill. Serve garnished with fruit, or with plain or whipped cream. Serves 4.
