

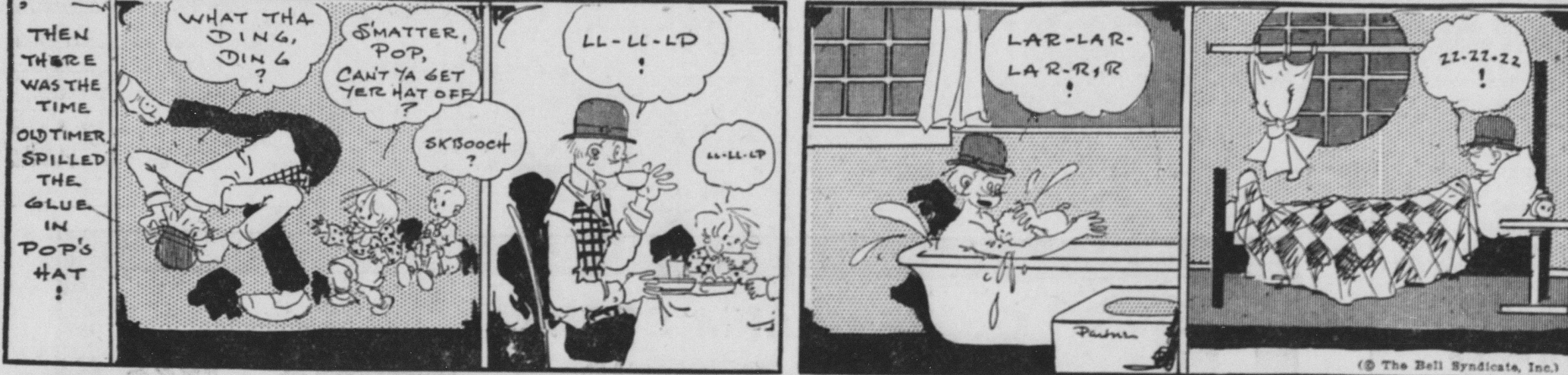

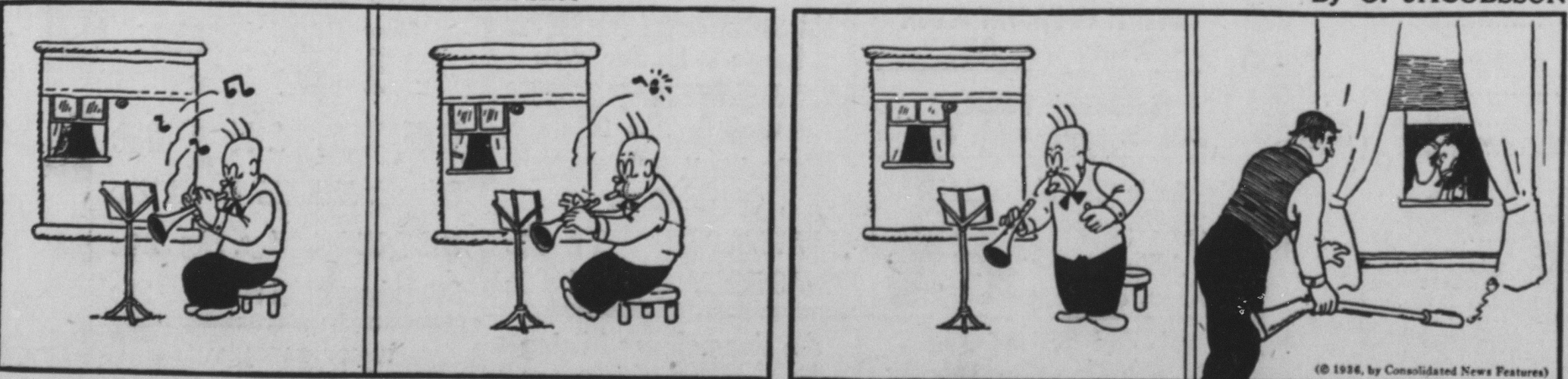

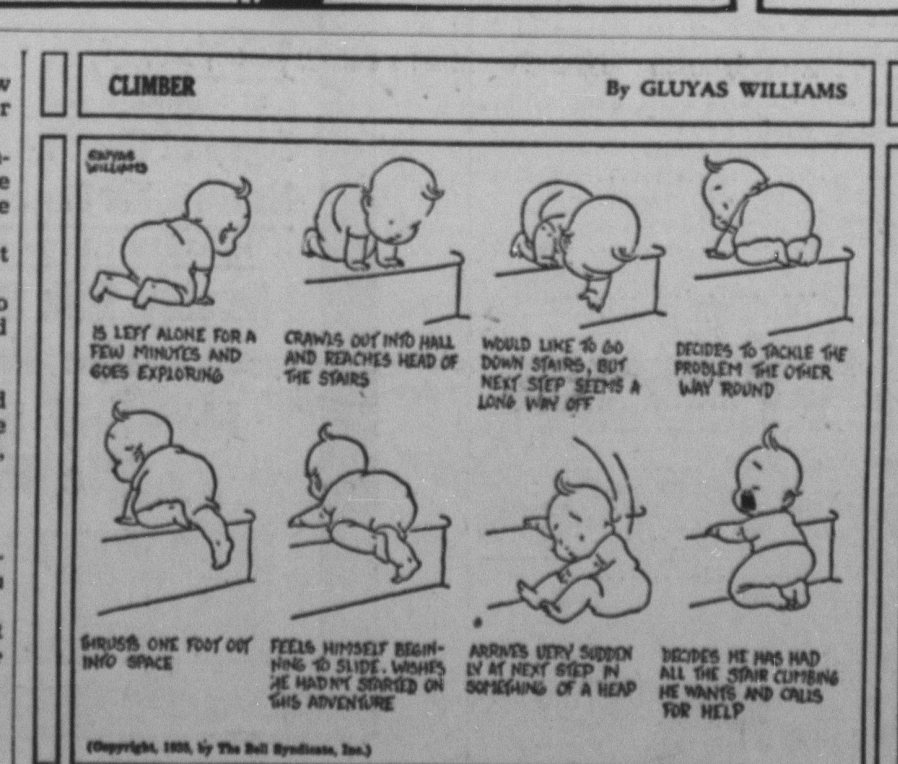

Terms of Senators and Representatives

Representatives are elected for two years by the direct popular vote in November of even years. Each house is a new body, although many representatives are re-elected. Under the 20th Amendment to the Constitution congress meets each year, beginning January 3. Thus there is a new house in January of the odd-numbered years.

This procedure differs from the Senate, in which the terms are so arranged that one-third of the senators are new every two years, making it a continuous body in that the terms are for six years.—Washington Post.
