- Caramel Corn**  
 1 cup white sugar 1/2 cup water  
 1/2 cup white corn 2 tablespoons butter  
 syrup 1/2 tablespoon vinegar  
 2 tablespoons 2 quarts pop corn  
 sorghum

Combine all ingredients except the corn. Cook until syrup becomes brittle when tested in cold water. Pour over popped corn, stirring the corn while pouring. Turn on to buttered platter.
