A JOINT RESOLUTION PROPO- DUBLIC NOTICE. SING CERTAIN AMEND-MENTS TO THE CONSTITU-

PE it resolved by the Scuate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of tennsylvania in General Assembly met. That the follow-ag amendments be proposed to the Constitution of the commonwealth, in accordance with the provisions of the of the Constitution, to be designated as section four, as follows:

"SECTION 4. Whenever any of the qualified electors of this Commonwealth shall be in any actual military service, under a requisition from the President of the United States, or by the authority of this Commonwealth, such electors may exected the right of suffrage in all elections, by the citizens, under such regulations as are, or shall be prescribed by law, as fully as if they were present at their usual place of election."

SECTION II. There shall be two additional sections to the elevant article of the Constitution, to be designated as sections eight, and mine, as follows.

"SECTION S. No bill shall be passed by the Legislature, containing more than one subject, which shall be clearly expressed in the title, except appropriation bills."

"SECTION O. No bill shall be passed by the Legislature granting any powers, or privileges, in any case, where the authority to grant such powers, or privileges, has been, or may hereafter be; conferred upon the courts of this Commonwealth."






