Kerosene for Henneries.

Where lice are troublesome in a henery, the use of kerosene will be found to answer an excellent purpose.

Careful observers will have noticed that there are several breeds of hen-lice to contend against. The species that attack sitting hens in hot weather are very small, very active in their motions, and multitudinous in their number.

We have not tried it in hens' nests, but have no doubt that if sprinkled through the hay or straw of which the nest is formed it will answer a better purpose than sulphur or ashes in the bottom.

The lice found on the heads and necks of young chickens are very large, compared with those infesting the nests of sitting hens, and we do not remember to have ever seen them except on fowls.
