Now, is the soil always wrong sid up for our crops? or is there any necessi for turning it over every time we wish plant a crop? It seems to be absolute needful that a sod should be turned over because, if reasonably stiff, no mechanic operation would break it up sufficiently for the crop, and even if this were possibl too much of the grass would remain the surface to grow and impede other of

We have full faith that an implemen (for we can hardly call it a plow) w sooner or later be invented, which thoroughly disintegrate the soil to a give depth, without the additional labor turning it over. It is true that this ha all been claimed for implements alread invented, and we have tried one of then but have found radical faults in it. Th implement goes by the name of a Rotar Spader, and a neighbor aptly compare its manner of working to a dog diggin out a ground hog; for it tears the soil u and throws it behind the machine in loese mass, and just in the proper cond tion for a crop. On the stoneless wester prairies, this implement works well; an the soil needs no harrowing, the corn dril following directly after it. Some of or neaders will no doubt ask how we are get our manure turned under? To suc we will reply in true Yankee style, by asl ing why turn manure under at all? W as agriculturists, try experiments, and, we think, fix results, only to have the reversed by others. All these things see to travel in circles; and once in a lor time we return to the original point, which is always found in imitating nature. N ture believes in surface manuring, an she does not often err in her practice; an all our fine drawn theories must come down to her facts. Nature does not reverse the soil after every crop. In our opinion the "model plow" will not reverse the soil, but will thoroughly disintegrate and leave it in proper order for the crop without further preparations.

Wet Boots. The Agriculturist gives the following advice to farmers who, next to fishermen, are apt to get their boots wet through :-"When the boots are taken off, fill them quite full with dry oats. This grain has a great fondness for damp, and will rapidly absorb the last vestige of it from the wet leather.
