SILVER DOLLARS.

The Silver Bill Passes the Senate by More Than a Two-Thirds Vote.

After a continuous session of seventeen hours the United States Senate, on Saturday morning, passed the Bland Silver bill, with certain amendments and additional sections, by the following vote:
