Eggs from Different Breeds. A correspondent of the Ohio Farmer says: "After repeated experiments with the different varieties of fowls, and comparisons with others who have experimented in the same direction, I have concluded that the laying capabilities of the principal varieties are about as follows:

- Light Brahmas and Partridge Cochins—eggs, 7 to the pound; lay 130 per annum. Dark Brahmas, 8 to the pound; 120 per annum. Black White, and Buff Cochins, 8 to the pound; 125 per annum. Plymouth Rocks, 8 to the pound; 15 per annum. Houdans, 8 to the pound; 150 per annum. La Fleche, 7 to the pound; 130 per annum. Black Spanish, 7 to the pound; 140 per annum. Leghorns, 9 to the pound; 160 per annum. Hamburgs, 9 to the pound; 150 per annum. Polish, 9 to the pound; 125 per annum. Bantams, 10 to the pound; 90 per annum.
