### THE REBELS ON THE CUMBERLAND RIVER—ANOTHER MOVEMENT TO PLANK ROSSCRANS.

CLARKSVILLE, April 3. Last night the steamers Reliance and Lizzie were fired into below Clarksville, on the Cumberland river. Both escaped capture.

The Glasgow arrived with guns this evening. She was fired into at Harpeth Shoals, and pilot and several of the crew were slightly wounded. The *Democrat's* correspondent says that the rebels, under Van Dorn, are attempting to flank Rosecrans on the left, and are crossing the River at Palmyra, and thinks that Van Dorn has a heavy supply of artillery.

### President's Proclamation for a Day of Illumination and Prayer.

"WHEREAS, The Senate of the United States, devoutly recognizing the supreme authority and just government of Almighty God in all the affairs of men and of nations, has, by a resolution, requested the President to designate and set apart a day for national prayer and illumination:

And whereas, It is the duty of nations, as well as of men, to own their dependence upon the over-ruling power of God, to confess their sins and transgressions, in humble sorrow, yet with assured hope that genuine repentance will lead to mercy and pardon, and to recognize the sublime truth, announced in the Holy Scriptures and proven by all history, that those nations only are blessed whose God is the true God:

And, inasmuch as we know that, by His divine law, nations, like individuals, are subjected to punishments and chastisements in this world, may we not justly fear that the awful calamity of civil war, which now desolates the land, may be but a punishment inflicted upon us for our presumptuous sins, to the needful end of our National reformation, to the peaceful enjoyment of the good gifts of Heaven.

Now, therefore, in compliance with the request, and fully concurring in the views of the Senate, I do, by my proclamation, designate and set apart Thursday, the 30th day of April, 1863, as a day of National illumination, fasting and prayer. And I do hereby request all the people to abstain on that day from their ordinary secular pursuits, and to unite, at their several places of worship, and their respective homes, in keeping the day holy to the Lord, and devoted to the humble discharge of the religious duties proper to that solemn occasion.

All this being done, in sincerity and in truth; let us then, rest humbly in the hope, authorized by the Divine teachings, that the united cry of the nation will be heard on high, and answered with blessings, no less than the pardon of our national sins, and the restoration of our divided and suffering country to its former happy condition of unity and peace.
