For the Spy. From the 195th Regiment. CAMP MONOCACY, Monocacy Junction, Aug. 2d '64.

Mr. Editor:—My first letter left you very pleasantly situated at Camp Man-ken's Woods, near Baltimore. All were participating a fine time at least for a few weeks' stay, and everything was being arranged for our comfort, but on Friday night, just as we were about turning in, orders came to draw two days' rations, strike tents, and be ready to march. All was new commotion, and preparation, and in an hour's time we were on our march for Baltimore. The night was warm and the march being a pretty quick one was pretty hard on new men, and all were glad when the word halt was heard, and we had reached Camden Station. The regiments not having arrived, the men quartered in the streets and slept soundly on the hard pavements until morning. About ten o'clock on Saturday we took the cars for Relay Station, and arrived there about noon. Pitched tents in an open field near the rail road and by evening were again ordered to be ready to march at a moment's notice; we again drew an extra supply of rations, and an increase of twenty rounds of ammunition, making it all sixty rounds. This began to look like some work, and the men began speculating upon the probabilities of a battle; however all were satisfied to move wherever needed and all were ready to do their duty. On Sunday morning we left for Monocacy, in an open truck train, with a burning sun falling upon us, and about four o'clock we arrived here, being seven hours on the road. Here we heard of the rebel raid into Pennsylvania, and all were anxious to be sent after the raiders, but it was ordered otherwise and of course we had to obey. We are now encamped on part of the late battle field, where Gen. Wallace was overpowered and compelled to retreat. All around are the marks of the severity of the struggle, and many graves mark the resting place of many a brave man. A number of rebel graves show that the battle was hotly contested and that they suffered severely, but being four to one they expelled our little army to give way after a contest of over four hours. On our arrival here we expected to have a little fight with the rebels, but as yet they have not made their appearance here in any force to bother us. A few ventured up to the Monocacy, but soon found it more convenient to retreat than pursue their course further. A large number of troops are collecting here, for what purpose is unknown, but you will no doubt hear from them soon, and that perhaps where least expected. We have force enough to thwart any movement into Maryland or Penn'a in force, and should there be any attempt of that kind they will find a force in their rear that they little expected to meet.

The boys are all enjoying themselves very well, and the health of the entire regiment is excellent. We have settled down into the regular routine of camp life, with Battalion and Company drills, and Dress Parades. The men are becoming more proficient every day in drill and the Col. says we are doing very well for green troops. Notwithstanding the hardships of a soldier's life, there are many pleasant times and many amusing incidents. A few evenings since a party of singers from several companies of the regiment proceeded to the Col.'s quarters and serenaded him. The Col. replied in a short address which was received with much enthusiasm. The Col. is much respected by all of his regiment and wherever he will lead, there you will find the 195th to discharge every duty, and be faithful to every trust. Our Co. is getting along admirably. The men are learning the drill as well as can be expected, and under Capt. Caldwell and our officers will in time make a good company. The officers are all loved and respected by the entire company and everything works smoothly and satisfactorily. This morning we had a visit from some of the boys of Strickler's Cavalry; they are all looking well and hearty and are now acting as an escort to Gen. Hunter, whose head quarters are here, the balance of the regiment, the 20th Pa. Cav., has been dismounted, the government not having the horses for them. We do not know how long we shall remain here, but presume we will be here until the movements of the rebels become more fully developed, and then we shall no doubt be after them. We have received no mail yet, since leaving Baltimore, and are consequently without any news from home, but hope soon to have our mail communication re-established. There is no news here that I can tell

you as it would be improper to speak of the movements of troops, and even that the government leaves us know but little, except what we see in our immediate neighborhood. All is being done that is possible and though there may be raids, and reverses, everything will work well in the end, and victory and peace will in due time crown our efforts. Our directions now are, "Co. E. 195th Reg't. P. V. 1st Separate Brigade, 8th Corps, Washington, D. C. Yours, S.

"Come on Boys, I've got the Flag!" (The dying words of Sergeant Christopher Donaghy, color-bearer of the Thirty-second Regiment of Massachusetts Volunteers in the battle of the Wilderness. He leaves a wife and one child to mourn his loss.—He bore his flag and escaped through all the great battles that his regiment was in, until the last day's fighting, when just after planting his colors on the Rebel breast-works, amid the heavy fire of the enemy, he received his death-wound. In his last moments of life his mind wandered back to the scenes of strife, and his last words were—"Come on, boys, I have the flag!")

Then the battle there I've borne it, Dearest treasure of my heart; Here at last I look upon it—From my idol now I part. A Female Soldier. A short time since a woman was arrested and taken to the Central Police Station, supposed to be a man dressed in female clothing. She stated that upwards of two years ago she, enlisted in a Minnesota regiment, in order to be near her husband who had joined the same regiment. Her husband was killed, and the wife remained with the regiment for twenty-two months, and participated in several hard fought battles.—Her time of enlistment having expired, she came to this city and was arrested as above stated. Upon her sex being discovered she was released and a substantial contribution collected for her comfort.—Nothing more was heard of her until yesterday morning, when she called at the Station house to think, (as she termed it) the officers who had previously assisted her. From her statement, it seems that after quitting this city, she visited Harrisburg, Pa., and joined a cavalry regiment. During the late demonstration against Peterburg, she received a wound in the right knee, when her sex was discovered. She was immediately furnished with suitable clothing and funds to enable her to reach her home and friends. When she encountered her yesterday, she presented a strange appearance and attracted great attention while passing along the streets. Her attire consisted of a calico skirt, zouave jacket, vest, a paper collar, cravat and dark gypsy hat, with the number 88th on the ribbon. She stated that she was on her way to New York, where she will, as soon as her wound heals, deliver lectures, descriptive of scenes and events, which transpired with her since joining the army. She is about thirty-five years of age, and very intelligent.—Balt. Clipper.

A Canadian journal reports that several "considerable droves of horses, purchased in Western Canada on Confederate account, have passed down on the royal mail steamers during the past few days, destined for Quebec. At that port, it is understood, they will be shipped for a Mexican port, and thence passed over into the Confederacy." Gen. Butler a day or two since arrested Chas. Gallagher, sutler, within his lines, for selling a bottle of liquor to a soldier, and confiscated four vessel loads of goods which he had in the river. It has been charged that Gen. Butler was making money through a connection with Gallagher's operations, who has been doing a very large and lucrative business; but this action will no doubt put a quietus upon these reports for the future.
