Thaddeus Stevens is just coming in from his committee-room, and looks so feeble, the great old man, it makes me sorry. The men abroad who assail him with such ferocity, if they could see him now, would be quite disarmed. He has stood here so long, his intellect is so powerful, his personality so positive, his utterance so unique, his spirit so masterful, his memory will not pass away with his presence, nor his name with his generation.
