Dr. Storrs embraced the opportunity to say that he would not, by word or deed indorse the management of that institution until it clanged its policy on the Slavery question. He showed its inconsistency in publishing Tracts on Dancing, Horse-racing, Gambling, Dripking, Tobacco-chewing and Smoking, while it not only refused to speak out plainly on the subject of the great sin of Slavery, but aciually mutilated some of the best publications in the English language, in order to please less be followed by hundreds of others; and the time, it is to be hop :d, is not far distant, when the public sentiment of every Christia i denomination in the free States, will be as plainly expressed as in the Church of the Pilgrime at Brooklyn .- Tribune
