AN ACT

In relation to establishing and changing the places of holding general elections throughout the Commonwealth.

Section 1. Be it enacted, etc. That upon the petition of one-third of the qualified voters of any election district...

Section 2. That the Courts of Quarter Sessions shall have authority within their respective counties to divide any borough, ward or township into two or more election districts...

Section 3. That no district so formed shall contain less than one hundred voters, and the proceedings had in the case of such division or alteration shall be the same as in the erection or alteration of the lines of townships.

Section 4. That the Courts of Quarter Sessions shall have authority within their respective counties to divide any borough, ward or township into two or more election districts...
