We Can't Fight Always - A Lincoln.

Such was the declaration of President Lincoln to the extra session of Congress. If we cannot fight always, then how long are we, or ought we, or must we fight? This Mr. Lincoln did not tell us then, nor has he given us any light upon the subject since.

When Mr. Lincoln first resolved upon war, having five thousand men were deemed quite a sufficient force to put down the rebellion. This was eighteen months ago. We have since called into the field one million two hundred thousand men, and spent, perhaps, not less than one thousand five hundred millions of dollars.
