Resolved, That the Common Schools of the county have, by this dispensation of Providence lost one of their warmest friends, a man ever willing and eager to give his time and council to the cause of education, and whose kind and gentlemanly deportment toward the Directors and Teachers of the county endeared him to all with whom he associated.
