Go preach to blocks and stones, go preach to the Dead, ye who deny the Immortality of the Affections! Go reason with the trees or hills or images of the wood, or with your motionless, icy souls, ye who believe because there is no marrying yonder, there shall be no embracing, or because we may not use the gentle words, "my wife," we may not clasp these sanctified forms in our own arms!

Linger not, O man, whoever thou art, for the formal coming of the great Judge and Savior of wayward, sinful men. For while you are inquiring and seeking for him he is near thee—around you knocking; yes, knocking at every door of your heart. In the daily and hourly events of life he is not far from any of us.
