Ability of the Treasury to Stand Increased Expenditure.
The Secretary of the Treasury reports that the amount of the public debt, on the first day of November, 1867, was \$2,041,044,460; and that on the first day of November, 1868, it amounted to \$2,027,129,552.82, which shows an increase of the debt, during the last year, of \$13,914,907.18.

It is shown that the internal revenue receipts for the years ending June 30, 1867, fall below the receipts for the year ending June 30, 1868, \$43,109,277.99, and that the receipts for the year ending June 30, 1868, fall short of the receipts for 1867, \$74,939,948.92.
