Helmbold's Column. THE KIDNEY!

The anterior sheath. Exterior consists of the outer or renal, which serves as a deposit for the urine and encloses it in the exterior. The anterior is a muscular sac, terminating in a single tube, and called the Ureter. The ureters are situated with the bladder.

The bladder is composed of various openings or sinuses, situated in part in the upper, lower, the Torrens, and the Mamma. The upper opens, the lower inferior. Many have a desire to urinate without the ability. Other ailments with the inability to retain. This frequently occurs in children.
