THE MILITIA TAX HURDLE.

Our readers are well aware that there is a statute requiring a list of 43 years, the payment of which exempts all such from military duty.

These are no volunteer organizations in this county, the funds they collected have heretofore gone into the County Treasury.

The Legislature last winter passed a supplement to the Militia law (see pamphlet law, 1870, page 63) which requires the list to be returned to the County Treasurer.

In proof of what we here state we submit the following tabular statement, which we have compiled from the official documents.
