AN ACT.

To regulate elections and punish frauds therein in the county of Clearfield.

SECTION 1.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, that it is hereby enacted by the authority of the State...

SECTION 2.

The oath to be taken by the officers holding such election shall be in the following words: 'I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that as an officer...

SECTION 3.

It shall be the duty of the officers of such election to ascertain objections made by any qualified elector to any vote that may be offered...

SECTION 4.

Any officer of said elections, who is called upon to testify in any proceeding...
