Rules and Regulations.—Directors should adopt a code of rules and regulations for the government of their schools. No movement would I think accomplish more for the benefit of the schools, decrease tardiness and absence, and have a greater tendency to awaken pupils and parents to the true interest of school affairs.

Non-Attendance.—About five hundred children, of proper school age, did not attend school during the year; or so seldom that it was of no practical advantage, but a great disadvantage to those that did attend.

Fault Finding.—In a few sections the schools would be more successful, if citizens would take more interest in co-operating with and assisting the Superintendent and teachers in their duties.

School Examinations were held at the close of the term, by a large number of teachers. A few held monthly examinations with good effect.

Conclusion.—My last election having been declared illegal, on account of an oversight in law by the Attorney in the organization of the Bridgeport Independent District, and not being an applicant for appointment, this report will close my official connection with the county.
