## Use of Metal as Fuel.

An inventor proposes to substitute metals for coal as fuel for ocean steamers, and has taken out a patent for a method of carrying out his views, his object being to obtain a large FLOUR & FEED DEPOT amount of steam from a given quantity of fuel.
