Children under ten years old, who accompanied by their parents or guardians, free, and unaccompanied by parents or guardians, one-half the amount of admission.

Exhibitors must have their animals and articles entered on the Secretary's books or otherwise registered with the Secretary for horses and for exhibits except horses for pleasure and for trotting premiums, must be brought within the enclosure as early as nine o'clock on Thursday evening, and must be exhibited on Friday morning.

INSTRUCTIONS TO JUDGES.

Premises and diplomas will be paid on and after the first Monday after the Fair, and until the first day of December, 1881, after which all monies received will be turned over to the Association as a donation to the Association.

The exhibitor must present his card to the Secretary, with the number and class upon them, and to the judge, and the judge will then be required to bring with him a bill of sale, and to have with him a list and full description of the animals and their names, and the number in the class, with the name of the exhibitor will appear on the card attached, but the name of the exhibitor will not be printed.

THE TROTTING CIRCLE.

The trotting course in level, well graded and one-half mile long, and the enclosure will be made available for the convenience and comfort of visitors.

INSTRUCTIONS TO JUDGES.

No animal or exhibit on exhibition for a premium or to receive a premium, will be admitted.

This does not embrace horses offered for the trotting premiums. Judges are expressly required not to award premiums to any animal.

It is required that the exhibitor be awarded to the class of which he shall appear to have been beaten only in the class of fat cattle; the object of the Association being to encourage the improvement of the cattle.

The number and class, and the number in the class, with the name of the exhibitor, will appear on the card attached, but the name of the exhibitor will not be printed.
