We are grieved to announce an outbreak on the part of some rioters in Shafterstown on Saturday evening last, who were very disorderly and caused considerable damage to the property of the community. The facts as near as we can get at them are about as follows. A number of Democrats, who were invited to the public house of M. K. Keath forming a Club for the benefit of the drafted, when they were assaulted by the rioters with stones with the intention of driving them away. They were badly wounded and several were injured. During the scene an elderly man named John was severely beaten while carrying them for throwing stones at Mr. Keath's hotel. Some ladies were also threatened and one was injured by the rioters. Windows were knocked out and a number of citizens injured. Such proceedings are a shame and a disgrace and should be severely punished.

As there will be quite a raid of Lebanon folk to Pottsville shortly for the purpose of exemptions and otherwise, in consequence of this, we take the liberty of suggesting to them that there is no better stopping place there than the Mortimer House kept by Jos. M. Feger. Let them make a note of this and act accordingly.

Four, was directed to notify the several Judges of the Courts of Lebanon County, of the death of Levi Kline, Esq., and to invite them to unite with the members of the bar and officers of the Court, in attending the funeral of the deceased.
