THE FORTITUDE OF COTTON.—Who gets THE LION'S SHARE.—A great deal of cotton is seized in the Southwest and sold ostensibly for the Government, but one or two sales recently reported, amounting in gross to \$60,513, the amount realized to the Government was but \$26,919.
