NOTHING LIKE A GOOD TRADE.—Provost Marshal General Fry has issued a circular to the effect that skilled mechanics and operatives employed in the arsenals and navy yards of the United States, who shall be drafted and on examination be held to service, will not be required to report for duty under such draft so long as they remain in the aforesaid service, provided the officer in charge shall certify that their labor as mechanics or operatives is necessary for the naval or military service.
