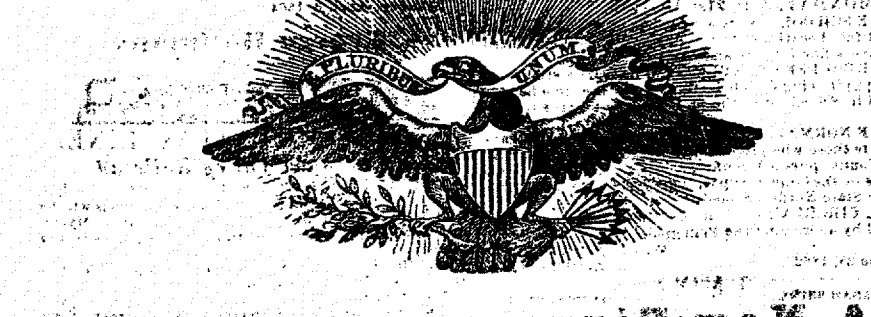

JOINT RESOLUTION IMPOSING A SPECIAL INCOME DUTY.

Be it resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That in addition to the income duty already imposed by law, there shall be levied, assessed, and collected on the first days of October, Eighteen hundred and sixty-four, a Special income duty upon the gains, profits, or income for the year ending the thirty-first day of December next, preceding the time herein named, by levying, assessing, and collecting said duty of all persons residing within the United States, or of citizens of the United States residing abroad, at the rate of five per centum on all sums exceeding six hundred dollars and the same shall be levied, assessed, estimated, and collected except as to the rates, according to the provisions of existing laws for the collection of an income duty, annually, where not inapplicable here to, and the Secretary of the Treasury is hereby authorized to make such rules and regulations as to time and mode, or other matter to enforce the collection of the special income duty here in provided for as may be necessary.
