Major Gen. George Hartsuff died in the Sturtevant House, New York, on Saturday night 16th inst. He was graduated from West Point July 1, 1852, and in March, 1861, had risen to the rank of Brevet Captain, Duringthe rebellion he served in Florida, Virginia, the West and Southwest, held various staff offices, and at one time commanded the Twenty-third Corps. He was in many battles, and was twice seriously wounded. He rose to the rank of Major General of volunteers and Brevet Major General of the regular army. At the time of his retirement he was Assistant Adjutant General of the Military Division of the Missouri, headquarters in Chicago, where he was well known and highly respected.
